- I was out two days this week. On those days, my substitute did reading, writing, and math activities that revolved around a theme. One day's theme was bats and the other day's theme was pirates.







Heggerty Phonemic Awareness Skills

- * listening to a word and choosing its rhyme (ex. day...Which word rhymes? Lock or way?
- * identifying beginning and ending sounds
- * blending onset & rime (ex. /d/ & -og = dog)
- * segmenting a word into onset & rime
- * deleting initial phonemes/sounds (ex. Take the /s/ away from sat & you have. -at.

Reading Group

- * reviewed what makes a story an informational text
- * talked about how to identify a text's central idea and key details
- * learned about text features in an informational text table of contents, headings, glossary and Index

Fundations Skills

- * learned the letters v and w, along with their keywords, sounds, and how to properly form/write them
