<u>Math</u>

- We finished up our unit on addition by working on adding vertically and solving addition word problems.
- Our math centers gave everyone the opportunity to practice adding, putting numbers in order, comparing numbers, counting with correspondence, writing numbers, and decomposing numbers.

Our Other Learning Activities

- We did a taste test to go along with the the book, <u>Edible Colors</u>. We tasted a rainbow! There were red pomegranate seeds, orange golden berries, yellow peppers, green honeydew & avocado, blue blueberries, and purple grapes. 





English Language Arts

Into Reading Module 4: Happy Healthy Me Week 3

Essential Question: How can I be my healthiest me?







Writing

We began talking about how-to writing. We learned that this type of writing teaches people how to do something. You can use the format 1, 2, 3 or first/next/then/last.

Reading Group

- * We practiced retelling stories. You want to include the characters, setting and what happened in the beginning, middle & end of the story.
- * We talked about what a fairy tale is. They are usually folktales, featuring magical characters, places and events.
- * We practiced reading high frequency words and decoding words.

Heggerty Phonemic Awareness Skills

- * producing rhyming words
- * identifying beginning & middle sounds
- * blending 3 phoneme words (ex. /d/ + /o/ + /g/ = dog)
- * segmenting words (ex. breaking down the word sun into the sounds /s/ /u/ /n/)

Fundations Skills

- * learning how to properly form uppercase letters C-L
- * tapping out words to read/decode them
- * worked on putting letters into alphabetical order and reviewed letter names & their sounds
