#### Math

- We began learning about addition. When you add, you join two groups together to find how many there are *in all*, which is similar to when you put two parts together to find the whole when composing numbers. We practiced telling addition stories and using objects to add.
- Our math center activities gave everyone a chance to practice counting with correspondence to 20, writing numbers, identifying amounts on 10-frames, composing numbers, decomposing numbers, and putting numbers in order.

### Our Other Activities

- We wrapped up our social studies unit on maps. For one activity, we went out to the front sidewalk and used a compass to identify & draw things we saw north, east, south and west of where we were standing (ex. When looking west, we saw the parking lot, trees, houses and Chucky's/Dunkin.) We also did an activity called "Me On The Map". Everyone drew their house, that is in our town-Voluntown, that is in the state of Connecticut, that is in our country United States Of America.
- Our literacy center activities gave everyone the opportunity to practice reading heart words, writing letters in sand, identifying letters & their sounds, identifying the ending letter sound in a given word, breaking down a word into syllables, and pairing up rhyming words.


