Our Other Learning Activities





Writing

During writing group, everyone finished filling out planning sheets for their *how-to* writing piece. Getting around seemed to be a theme. Riding a bike, riding a 4-wheeler, riding a dirt bike and riding a quad were topics selected by some of the kiddos. With our planning done, everyone began writing in their mini books.

Fundations Skills

- * learned how to do dictation (listen to a word, tap it out to hear the sounds and then write the word)
- * decoded words in print
- * reviewed letter names & their sounds
- figured out if a word had a long or short vowel sound

Reading

- * We reviewed what a folktale is. They usually feature talking animals and teach some sort of lesson.
- * We learned a little bit about plays. They have a cast (characters played by actors), a narrator (someone who tells the story) and a script (tells the actors what to say).
- *We worked on reading high frequency words/heart words and decoding words.

Heggerty Phonemic Awareness Skills

- * producing rhyming words
- * identifying beginning & middle sounds
- * blending 3 phoneme words (ex. /d/ + /o/ + /g/ = dog)
- * segmenting words (ex. breaking down the word sun into the sounds /s/ /u/ /n/)
