## Math

- We continued working on subtracting. This week vertical subtraction was introduced and practiced.
- Our math center activities gave everyone an opportunity to practice subtracting, finding numbers on the 100 chart, and finding \& showing numbers to 20 on a 10 -frame, counting with correspondence, and writing numbers.


## Our Other Learning Activities

- Our literacy center activities gave everyone an opportunity to practice decoding words, identifying the ending letter sound in a word, writing \& reading heart words/high frequency words, writing letters, and figuring out the middle vowel sound in a word.

We celebrated being 100 days smarter with activities such as doing 100 exercises, reading a decodable book about the 100th day, writing about 100 things we'd like to have \& 100 things we wouldn't want to have, making making a picture with 100 dot stickers and eating a snack of 100 yummy things.
