<u>ELA</u>

- We began using our phonics program, *Fundations*, and our phonemic awareness program, *Heggerty* this week. During our beginning of the year *Fundations* lessons, we will learn about letters & their sounds and how to write letters. This week we worked on lowercase t, b and f. Our *Heggerty* lessons feature a lot of word games rhyming words, identifying beginning sounds in words, putting two words together to make a compound word, counting the words in a sentence, and more.
- During writing group, we read a couple stories about writing stories and talked a little bit about writing workshop that there will be a mini lesson, some time for writing and time for sharing our writing with the class.
- We began Module 1: Curious About Kindergarten in our reading program, *Into Reading*. The topic was introduced, some related vocabulary words were introduced, and we read a couple stories about going to school.

<u>Math</u> - We have been working on developing number sense. During group time, we have been learning that there are a few different ways to show numbers - a word, an amount, or a numeral. We have also been exploring different math manipulatives during our math centers time.

<u>Social Studies</u> - Our social studies group discussions have been focused on rules – what are our school rules and why having rules are important.
